## **BYLAW CHANGE**

**MOTION: To amend Article IV- The Intergroup Board, Section 4 C by striking**

<b><u>CURRENT WORDING</u></b>	<b><u>PROPOSED WORDING</u></b>
Method of election for board members, region reps and WSBC Delegates: Section 4 - Method of Election A. Elections shall be held annually at a meeting specified for that purpose. B. To be eligible for election to the board, nominee must: a. 1) Meet all qualifications as defined in Article IV, Section 3. b. 2) Understand responsibilities of the position as defined in Article IV, Section 6, and as defined in the Intergroup job descriptions. C. In order to be elected to membership on the Intergroup Board, a nominee must be physically present at the election meetings and must receive a majority vote of all members present and voting. **INTENT:** To eliminate the requirement that a person be physically present to be voted on. They may then attend the meeting via the phone bridge and be considered.
