  - Total income for the year is at \$58,000. Expenses do not yet include the Buffalo retreat expenses. Next month will reflect all retreat expenses.
  - Prudent reserve is at \$15,000. Operating account is over \$60,000. Will go down next month.
  - It appears that we will do slightly better than break even on the Buffalo retreat.
  - Molly moved to accept the report; second by Liz Z. March Treasurer's report approved.
  - If any committees have expenses or expect expenses for the next fiscal year, please let Betty or Jean know so it is included in the next budget. We will start to consider the budget in May and complete it in June.

Jean reminded us that last summer, prior to transition from Region 4 to Region 5, UIG updated all meeting information.
  - Region 5 is looking for groups to host future in-person region Assemblies.
  - Spread the word about the Region 5 Convention May 23-25. They are doing a la carte pricing so registration and meals to keep costs low.
  - Region is focusing on supporting contact between intergroups to share resources and events, and create connections. Region 5 wants to support our intergroup. We can invite officers to work with us.
